





<p>Revised National Standards</p> <p><i>NARU produces 'National Standards' for NHS England in relation to interoperable capabilities. These are then incorporated in the EPRR Core Standards and become contractual obligations on Trusts.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HART: Due Feb18 following the outcomes of the National Capability Reviews (the audits). • MTFA: Due Feb18. These will now be drafted against the existing MTFA capability and JOPs Ed.4. They will be revised again when the enhanced capability is agreed with NHS England and DH. • CBRN: Due Feb18. Final draft being prepared for consultation. • Mass Casualties: Due Mar18. Awaiting DH commission to roll out revised model. • Command and Control: Due Jan18. Complete. Currently clearing NHS England Gateway publication process. 	<p>Safe System Components (SOPs etc)</p> <p>SOPs: Text simplified for all. All now in final / published versions with the exception of Generic Provisions which is currently being rewritten. MTFA SOP needs a final review with national leads.</p> <p>GRPs: All need to be reviewed following the recent SOP changes. Final drafts will be published by the end of Jan18.</p> <p>GORAs: Complete – due to be published on the system by 4th Jan 18.</p> <p>TISs: All now subject to final review following publication of SOP final drafts. Final alignment taking place in Jan18.</p> <p>EDSs: NS producing master list (numbers and titles). EDS's all now aligned to capabilities in the new matrices and uploaded to system. Outstanding Infectious Disease EDS.</p>
<p>Matrices</p> <p>Revised Matrices have been produced for the HART capabilities. These include the key activities covered, the limitations of the capabilities and reference the minimum training requirements and equipment provisions. It also sets the minimum safe staffing levels for each capability.</p> <p>These drafts will be taken to the next Operations Group meeting in February for approval.</p> <p>CBRN, MTFA and Mass Casualty Matrices will follow in March / April.</p>	<p>National Capability Reviews (the Audits)</p> <p>All mainland England Ambulance Trust have now been reviewed.</p> <p>A national (collated) report will be drafted in January and provided to NHS England. This will feed into the review of National Standards.</p> <p>The Isle of Wight will be reviewed in January but the findings from this will not be included in, or affect, the national mainland report.</p>
<p>Change Management Process </p> <p>Now live. All changes to processes, training provisions and equipment involved in the interoperable capabilities must be put through this online system via the Proclus Dashboard.</p>	
<p>Safety Notification System </p> <p>The new Safety Notification System is scheduled to go live via the Proclus Dashboard this month.</p> <p>Once live, all safety issues that affect interoperable capabilities should be raised via this system. The system will then be used to trigger national safety alerts. More information will be provided at the next National Operations Group.</p>
